## Make a Pledge

**Fill out a Pledge Card:** The easiest way to participate is to simply fill out the enclosed Pledge Card which gives the Stewardship committee the best indication of what goals can be pursued and budgeted in the year to come. We are formally collecting and blessing Pledge Cards on December 3<sup>rd</sup>, but they can be returned to the parish office anytime if that is more convenient for you. You can mail the card in, drop it off at the parish office, or simply email the parish office at <a href="mailto:marie@christchurchpelham.org">marie@christchurchpelham.org</a>. You can request offering envelopes, and you can pay your Pledge via check, cash, online, or via credit card (see below).

## Ways to Donate and Pay your Pledge

- 1) **Cash or Check:** You can pay your pledge via check or cash, and you can request offering envelopes for that that can be placed in the collection plate on Sundays.
- 2) Parish Giving Online Pledging: Scan the QR code to the right and join many of our members who donate and pledge through *Parish Giving*. You can give a one-time donation, setup a regular pledge (weekly, monthly, quarterly, annually, whatever works for you), or set up one-time or recurring donations (for Easter, Christmas, Mother's Day, special occasions, etc.). *Parish Giving* makes it easy, and if your donation comes from your bank account the church pays minimal processing fees.



3) **Venmo:** Venmo @ChristChurchPelham or scan the <u>Venmo QR code</u> to the right, and you can give to Christ Church through Venmo. Please note that the Church pays a processing fee of about 3% when you use Venmo.



- 4) **Credit Card / Tap:** The Parish Office has a credit card scanner, and you can pay all or part of your pledge in person using a credit card or tap (iPhone, Android, Smartwatch, etc.). Please note that the Church pays a processing fee of about 3% when you use a credit card.
- 5) **Stocks, Securities, Etc.:** Please contact the Parish office if you would like to pay your pledge or make a donation using stocks, securities, etc.

If you are pledging online, please do fill out a pledge card to make things easier for the Parish Office.
