


Sunday School Resumes on Sunday September 7.





Walters Hot Dogs! Sunday September 21, 11am-1pm

Wednesday September 10






Father Matt's Bible Study resumes 8:00am, Thursday, September 5

Father Matt's Bible Study takes an academic look at the Scriptures, providing historical and geopolitical context, narrative context, and discussions about translations and manuscript variants. Over the past years we have read numerous books from start to finish, including Isaiah, Ezekiel, Job, Ruth, Obadiah, Jonah, Daniel, The Psalms, Gospel of Matthew, Gospel of John, 1&2 Thessalonians, Philemon, and Revelation. Currently, we are reading Genesis, and we will resume at chapter 37 on September 7. When we finish Genesis we will continue with Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy.

SAINT MICHAEL & ALL ANGELS

Join us for the Feast of Saint Michael and All Angels (Michaelmas) on Sunday, September 28, at 4:00pm.

Evensong is one of the most beautiful and spiritual parts of the Anglican Tradition. Our full Parish Choir will sing Evensong, and our preacher will be the Rev. Christian Wood, Rector of Saint John's Church, Tampa, Florida. Father Wood is Fr. Matt's cousin-in-law, and he is also on staff with me at the Saint Michael's Youth Conference each summer.

Evensong is a sung service of Evening Prayer. Evensong has been offered for nearly 600 years in Anglican and Episcopal cathedrals, city churches, and country parishes around the world. The format for Anglican Evensong can be traced directly to the first Book of Common Prayer and Archbishop Thomas Cranmer who crafted it from the smaller monastic offices that had been in use before the Reformation. Evensong is often offered on Sundays or Holy Days.

Michaelmas (rhymes with "nickel" and pronounced like "Christmas") is the traditional English name for the feast day of Saint Michael and All Angels, observed on September 29.

After Evensong we will have Pizzeria Night in the Undercroft with a variety of pizzas, and fun games including pool, foosball, shuffleboard, and the MLB Playoffs or NFL Football will be shown on our 65" TV. 
